## France's Pascal and Finland's Repo Take Downhill #6 Wins

**Mickael Pascal** (FRA, Be-One Team) and **Katja Repo** (FIN, Team GT) dominated a tough field of competitors - and a tough downhill track - to capture victory in round six of the **Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup** in Leysin, Switzerland. With unpredictable rains and tricky course conditions ruling the day, it was never clear who would prevail on the steep mountains above Lake Geneva. But thousands of fans came out to watch the excitement, this season's first triple event held in Europe.

Thirty women qualified for Saturday's afternoon finals, as **Katja Repo** (FIN, Team GT) topped the semi-final list in sunny conditions - on ideal track conditions following the previous evening's rainfall. **Anne-Caroline Chausson** (FRA, Volvo-Cannondale) qualified second, with **Sabrina Jonnier** (FRA, RSP Import Intense) and **Missy Giove** (USA, Global Racing Team) next fastest in the morning session.

Then, in the afternoon finals, the rains came back and made the course unpredictable and very muddy for the competitors. **Anneke Beerten** (NED, Be-One) posted the first competitive time midway through the finals, coming down the mountain just as conditions began to improve for the remaining women.

**Celine Gros** (FRA, Scott USA) - who finished third here last season - next took over the hotseat, just as the sun came back out on the scenic mountains surrounding Leysin. She remained there until the top-two qualifiers raced across the finish.

First Chausson beat her time by nearly a minute, but it wasn't enough for the win on this day. Top-qualifier Repo came across next, and beat Chausson's time by 6.3 seconds - earning the "Flying Finn" her first-ever world cup victory.

"It's nice to get my first win - I knew I could do well in the mud," she said afterward. "I wasn't too nervous - when it's wet you don't have to go crazy fast, and I just wanted a clean run."

For Chausson it represented her season's first defeat, as she now turns her attention to the overall picture for the season. "I made a lot of mistakes - I didn't crash but it was my worst run of the season. Overall I'm happy though, with my results - not my race. I was hoping to win all my races this season, but don't think it's really possible for me. Now I have less pressure, which is easier on me."

Chausson leads the overall standings by 365 points over #2 **Missy Giove** (USA, Global Racing Team), who finished 6th today. Repo is ranked third overall.
