Venue: Houffalize, BEL- XC#9- 30-31 August 1997

Yet another display of controlled riding by Olympic Champion, *Paola Pezzo (ITA, Gary Fisher)*, left her rivals in no doubt about her form for the up-coming World Championships on September 21. The Italian attacked the field only three kilometres into the race and by the six kilometre mark had a lead of 25 seconds. That was the race decided, and virtually the Series too. Pezzo now has to finish 13th or better at next weekend's final in Annecy to claim the World Cup.

Pezzo may be the hottest prospect for a world championships win since the sport began, but that event is hardly weighing on her mind. "So far this season all I have thought about was the World Cup. I've not thought much about the world championships. I will have a think about that after Annecy (World Cup finals)," she remarked.

After the previous world cup race, at Vail, Pezzo claimed that she would not be trying to win here, and so relaxed was she today during her cruise to victory that she had time to joke with a course-side journalist about the smart jacket and tie he was wearing. Pezzo is known for her interest in fashion, and is always immaculately attired. Today, for the first time this year, she wore a knee-length version of the gold-sequinned 'sparklepants' that she has made her trademark this year.



The Ardennes course here was less technically challenging than in past years. In several of the forest sections, single track had previously formed the route, but in places this had been overlayed with wide trails made by forestry vehicles operating in the area.

Second place was taken by a resurgent *Alison*Sydor (CAN, Volvo-Cannondale), who did not attempt to compete with Pezzo early in the race, but on the last lap closed the gap by 20 seconds. On her way up through the rankings, Sydor went past first a tiring Chantal Daucourt (SUI, Trek Volkswagen) and then a cramping Margarita

Fullana (ESP, Liberto Megamo). Reigning World Champion Sydor had dislocated her shoulder in a crash at Vail and has compromised its recovery a little in her desire to say fit. "It hurts a bit during the race, but so do my legs!" Said Sydor, sporting a short Annie Lennox hair style in platinum blonde.

About this, she explained that, "Sometimes a superficial change can help bring about a change in attitude." It has not been an easy year for Sydor, whose pre-season was interrupted by a snowboarding injury in her pelvic region. This year Pezzo is presenting a monumental challenge to Sydor's world title, which she has held for the past three years.

Margarita Fullana, a relative newcomer to mountain biking, had to run down some of the slippery descents here, but she managed to hold off Daucourt and finish third. Daucourt is at the end of a period of heavy training in preparation for the World Championships.
