Evans Climbs Back to the Top

Australia's Cadel Evans laid to waste all those who would challenge him on the steep climbs of the mountains north of Madrid. The win put the '98 World Cup winner back on top of the Diesel-UCI World Cup standings.

It was a hard race that only got tougher as it progressed. The final hour was raced in steady rain, but the 25,000 Spanish cycling fans never let up cheering at the trackside as the diminutive Evans took a win of gigantic proportion. At the finish he was 3' 32" ahead of second placed **Bas Van Dooren** (NED) and 4' 04" clear of his long-time rival **Miguel Martinez** of *France*. Such big gaps are seldom seen in men's world cup racing these days.

The 3km climb on the 7km course was a key factor in stringing out the field. On the first lap of six the flyweight Evans bided his

time while *Frenchman* **Ludovic Dubau** launched an attack that set him 16" clear of **Hernando Hermida** (*ESP*), and 23" up on Evans at the end of lap one. The Under-23 world champion, Miguel Martinez (FRA), followed in fourth place at 46", accompanied by Van Dooren, *Norwegians* **Rune Hoydahl** and **Haakon Austad**, and *Swiss* riders **Thomas Hochstrasse** and **Thomas Frischknecht**.

Dubau was still in the lead at the end of the second lap, but Evans was closing the gap and crossed the line only 7" behind. With the main climb starting shortly after the start/finish line, it would not be long before Evans caught and passed the Frenchman.

As the riders crossed the finish line at the end of lap three, The order had changed. Evans now had a lead of 30" over Dubau, Frischknecht had moved up into third, at 50", Martinez was fourth at 55", accompanied by **Dario Cioni** (*ITA*), while Van Dooren and Hoydahl were next across the line, at 1'11". Evans continued to extend his lead until the finish.

As the riders made their way around the fourth lap, the rain started falling. What had been a difficult descent of 2km now became treacherous. Brake performance became critical and some riders commented on the advantage disc brakes offered in the wet conditions.

On a sharp descent 2km from the end of the lap, Frischknecht lost control at a corner and collided with a photographer standing near the track. In the ensuing crash he buckled his rear wheel and was obliged to true it in order to continue, he estimated that this took around four minutes. With a wobbly back wheel, Frischknecht remounted and had to disengage his rear brake in order to complete the race. He had just taken over second place when he crashed. At the end of the race he was 16th.

Van Dooren surged forward in the middle of the race and by the end of the fourth lap he was in fourth place. Cioni was 16" behind him and Martinez was 6" further back riding with Dubau. Martinez moved into third place on the fifth lap, and the postiions remained this way until the end. Dubau and Cioni swapped positions on the final lap, and the Frenchman finished fourth.

For Evans, this victory in the rain established him as the rider to beat in the early part of the season. But with two weeks until the next round, at <u>St Wendel</u> on 8-9 May, a lot could change.

Cadel Evans (1st)

"This type of course suits me well... My new disc brakes were good in both the dust and the rain... When it started raining the air got cold and the course got slippery, even when dry (the ground surface) was unpredictable... On laps four and five, when I saw the gap really opening behind me I felt more confident, but in a world cup race anything can happen."

Bas Van Dooren (2nd)

"I got worried when it started raining because I had put on semi-slick tyres before the race. But it worked out well for me... The reason I missed the first and second world cup rounds was to focus on the European championships."
