XC #3 - HOUFFALIZE, BEL - 29/30 APRIL

The Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup resumed racing after a three-week break this weekend, attracting an estimated 30,000 spectators and perfect racing conditions to the charming Ardenne town of Houffalize, in southern Belgium. Set amongst green hills and historic buildings, the town was at a standstill Sunday as the huge crowds lined one of the sport's most enduring courses.

Women began racing at 10:30 a.m. under cool grey skies, 87 international athletes contesting 3 3/4 laps of a long 9 km track. **Marga Fullana** (ESP, Subaru-Specialized), who DNF'd in Napa Valley's round one and missed round two in Mexico, took immediate control of this third round, leading several contenders through a three-quarter length start lap and into their first full lap.

Alison Dunlap (USA, Team GT), who finished 2nd in both of the previous

rounds, was feeling very strong, and took over the lead in lap two – quickly putting nearly 25 seconds on the Spanish champion within one lap. **Corine Dorland** (NED, Be-One) was riding steadily in third position, while **Mary Grigson** (AUS, Gary Fisher/Saab) and teammate Olympic Gold Medallist **Paola Pezzo** (ITA, Gary Fisher Saab) rounded out the top-five in the early running.

Dunlap punctured her rear tyre in the second full lap, losing 2 1/2 minutes and several positions before returning to action. This gave Fullana the lead back, which she kept for the remainder of the race. Corine Dorland gave a strong chase, and even if she couldn't beat Fullana, Fullana was also unable to shake the Dutch newcomer. While Fullana and Dorland rode closely together up front, Grigson and Pezzo created a secondary battle approximately 40 seconds back while Dunlap worked her way back to the 5th position.

In the 3rd (bell) lap Fullana was finally able to shake Dorland by 8 seconds, while Grigson – a minute later – put nearly a minute on a surging Dunlap who had displaced Pezzo, now in 5th position. **Elsbeth Vink** (NED, Subaru-Specialized), who worked her way up from 10th position and then paced behind Dunlap, was now in 6th position.

At the finish line Fullana grabbed a Spanish flag from her boyfriend/manager and waved it high as she repeated her win from last season's world cup finals here in Houffalize. Corine Dorland crossed the line 21 seconds later, happy with her career-best finish, while Mary Grigson held on for 3rd place. Alison Dunlap capped her powerful return to the podium with a 4th place finish, while Elsbeth Vink captured her career-best finish with 5th.

Quoted:

1st Place - Marga Fullana:

"I felt so bad for the last week, I was sick with a cold and so today was very difficult -I had a lot of pain in my legs. But when you're in the front you get a lot of power, and Corine was so strong today -I was surprised."

2nd Place - Corine Dorland:

"This is my best finish, and I really worked hard for it. I felt great all this past week, and am happy to do well here because it is so important for my nation's Olympic selection process."

Next stop of the Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup is round #4 of the cross-country tour, next weekend in St. Wendel Germany.
