## **Double Win for Team Subaru-Specialized**

Marga Fullana (ESP, Subaru-Specialized) and Filip Meirhaeghe (BEL, Subaru-Specialized) repeated their victorious results from round three of this season, when the two elite cross-country pros gave their team a pair of impressive wins to finish out the 2000 season in Lausanne, Switzerland. With rain and mud the most determining factor on a long 9 km course, both riders met the challenge and ground their way through the woods outside this picturesque Swiss city to put an important stamp on their season finales.

Marga Fullana (ESP, Subaru-Specialized) knew she wasn't in the running for the world cup overall coming into this final race, as she skipped the North American rounds of racing to prepare for her one goal this season - the Olympics. She also wasn't happy to see the muddy conditions develop in Lausanne this past week, as she prefers hard climbs to flat courses - especially if there is mud.

But the flyweight Spanish rider, who with two world cup wins this season is also this year's World Champion, seemed to revel in the conditions as she rode behind another three-time world cup winner, **Barbara Blatter** (SUI, Scott USA). Blatter was the local favorite, and both are slated to do well in the Olympics - so this race was a bit of a showdown.

With 40 women starting the race, competitors had a start loop, plus a short lap and three full laps of muddy conditions ahead of them. Fullana shadowed Blatter until the final lap, as the two riders put a minute on two other women by mid-race.

Blatter found herself in the lead for much of the race, and was comfortably in the overall Barbara Blatter - SUI world cup lead - especially with nearest rival **Alison Dunlap** (USA, Team GT) skipping this race. For her, the plan wasn't even to complete the entire race, but to ride for a couple laps and pull out.

"I planned to drop after two laps," she said, "but I was in the lead so I kept going."

Hedda Zu Puttlitz (GER, Be-One) and Elsbeth Vink (NED, Subaru-Specialized) were riding together in chase formation, while two more Germans - Sabine Spitz (Merida) and Regina

Marunde (Focus) rode with local heroine Chantal Daucourt (SUI, Trek Volkswagen) in 7th position.

But soon enough the attacks came in full up front, when Fullana experienced a slight chain problem going through the start/finish for the final lap. This gave Blatter the impetus to attack off the front, but Fullana was ready. She gave chase for the next couple kilometers, and caught Blatter on the backside of the course. She then counter-attacked, just as Blatter's form collapsed.

"I had to work too much," said Blatter. "My legs died, and I could hardly climb."

After leaving Blatter, Fullana made swift work of the final lap, putting an eventual 47 seconds on her chaser only the chaser now wasn't Blatter but teammate **Elsbeth Vink** (NED, Subaru-Specialized). As Blatter and Fullana had battled off the front, Vink attacked Zu Puttlitz for third place.

But she wasn't through, and while Blatter went backward several positions, Vink not only passed her, but Zu Puttlitz and Spitz as well, the two Germans moving to 3rd and 4th positions.

"I was very fast in the second and third laps," said Vink. "I was pacing with Hedda before I attacked, and was then happy to pass Barbara also on the final lap. I actually saw Marga ahead, but couldn't catch her."

Fullana then surged to the win several minutes later, after two hours, ten minutes of racing. She seemed never to doubt that she could do it.

"In the last lap Barbara attacked, but I counter-attacked and passed her," she said through a face of mud afterward. "I was worried about the mud before the race, but prepared psychologically, and said to myself I don't care what the conditions are, I can do well no matter what.""

"This was like a test for the Olympics," she added. "I wanted to see if I'm in shape."

With her finish, Blatter wins the world cup overall, with Dunlap second and **Alison Sydor** (CAN, Volvo-Cannondale) - who finished 15th after experiencing brake problems - finished the season 3rd overall. Fullana ends the season ranked 4th.
