# Italian Newcomer Martino Fruet Stuns Field With First Win

Racing at round two of the *Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup* heated up in Mexico Sunday, when a fast-moving men's field yielded a new winner in **Martino Fruet** (*ITA*, *Ritchey-Yahoo!*) emerging with a smile from a dusty, technical course. After nearly two and a half hours of intense competition, Fruet came up with the power in the final lap, beating veteran rider **Rune Hoydahl** (*NOR*, *Giant*) by a mere 26 seconds in front of an estimated 12,000 spectators.

The action was fast and hot Sunday afternoon, as 129 men lined up for seven laps of racing on this 6.6 km seaside course, plus one 600 meter start loop. Several top riders were missing from the line-up, including **Miguel Martinez** (FRA, Full Dynamix) and **Michael Rasmussen** (DEN, Haro/Lee Dungarees). Several other top riders would end their day early from flat tires, including **Bas Van Dooren** (NED, Be-One), **Thomas Frischknecht** (SUI, Ritchey) and **Roland Green** (CAN, GT).

For the remaining riders, it became partly a race of will and technical prowess, partly a race of attrition. The course's main characteristic is its dust and singletrack, making passing difficult for those back in the pack but generally not affecting those in the lead groups.

For Van Dooren and Frischknecht, the attrition factor appeared quickly, as both flatted out of the race's front group by the second lap, opening the lead to one of this early season's hottest new riders, **Lado Fumic** (GER, German National Team). Fumic took advantage of his speed and technical skills to remain in first or second position for every single lap.

Fruet, meanwhile, was toiling further back as he tried to make up ground from his start loop. Admitting his lack of speed in the start, Freut claimed the course's technical challenges were perfect for his

riding style and he quickly made up ground as the race progressed.

He went from 18th position in the first lap and passed several positions per lap until, by lap four, he was in 5th place. Two laps later he was 3rd and by the final lap was chasing the leader in second position.

That leader - until the final lap - was Rune Hoydahl (NOR, Giant), who had moved up from an 8th place start to overtake the German Fumic in lap four and control nearly all of the race's remains. With Fumic and Fruet now chasing Hoydahl for the lead in close quarters, the stage was set for a final-lap battle to the finish.

Fruet finally wrested the lead from Hoydahl toward the end of the sixth lap, after the Norwegian lost some control in a tight corner. Hoydahl was unable to reel in the flying Italian in the final lap and conceded the win by 26 seconds.

Fumic held on for third, while **Ludovic Dubau** (FRA, Marin) who had a steady afternoon in the top-five for most of the race held on to 4th place for the finish after challenging for a medal several times. Other notable finishes include **Rob Woods** (AUS, AIS GT-Australia) in 5th place after working his way up from 11th in lap

two, and countryman **Paul Rowney** (AUS, AIS New Balance Giant) who finished in 6th place after an outstanding race in the lead group.

With his win, Martino Fruet captured the blue Tissot leader's jersey, 33 points ahead of second-ranked Lado Fumic and **Marcel Heller** (SUI, Arrow Swiss Bike) both of whom have 260 points. Hoydahl is one point behind them. The Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup Cross-Country series will continue on April 30th with round three in Houffalize, Belgium.

## **1st Place Martino Fruet:**

"I'm so happy. When I passed Hoydahl I realized I was more strong today, and also I'm more small and that's important on this type of course. This is my perfect course, because I like the courses that are technical. But I had some problems in the start loop, because usually I'm not so strong in the start. Today is great for my team, they always tell me that the most important thing is the mind, the mind and when the race start I just go, go, go. My best finish before this was the bronze medal in the U-23 World Championship. I finished 13th two years ago in Silves, Portugal."


# 2nd Place Rune Hoydahl:

"I knew if I had a good start I could do well on this course because it's very technical. I was just sitting there for two laps and tried not to use too much energy to keep my speed the whole time. But the last lap, with Fruet I had no chance. I nearly crashed in one corner in lap six, and Fruet got a gap and was so strong, I couldn't close it. It's great to finish second today though and I felt that in Napa I was better than 17th place. It was good for me to have this result today, because I qualify for the Sydney Olympics with the Norwegian federation."

## 3rd Place - Lado Fumic:

"In the first lap I was riding well and Frischknecht was riding well also, but he got a flat tire and I got the first lead. Then Bas Van Dooren (NED, Be-One) came and we were riding together, but he was riding too risky and got a flat tire too so here I am. The last two weeks were really my courses a lot of singletrack and technical. I compare it with the last European Championships, where I was 6th the courses were similar, very hard."
