

## **Fullana and Martinez Win Italian World Cup Time Trial**

Sunny skies and ideal racing conditions greeted round two of the Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup on Saturday, as a large contingent of pro men and women began a weekend of cross-country racing with the second-ever official time trial event in Sarentino, Italy. Set in the mountains of Italy's South Tyrol region, this week's event is the second of the circuit's eight-race series for 2001.

And at the season's first event on European soil, it was *Spain's* **Marga Fullana** (*Specialized*) and *France's* **Miguel Martinez** (*Full Dynamix*) who dominated the large fields of contenders, as they completed one lap on Sarentino's technical course in solo runs against the clock.

**WOMEN'S REPORT: Marga Fullana** (ESP, Specialized), who already holds the title of World Champion, made her 2001 world cup debut at Sarentino's event, having missed round one in Napa last month. She was looking to test herself against the competition for Sunday's crosscountry event. And, after beating a field of 63 women, she proved that she is indeed in form, as she topped teammate and 2000 world cup champion **Barbara Blatter** (SUI, Specialized) by nearly 22 seconds.

"I'm very happy, and wanted to test myself for Sunday," Fullana said. Asked if she knew how she was doing during the one-lap event, she responded "I had two team staff members on the climb, and could see how Mary Grigson was doing in front of me - but it's hard to know exactly how I was doing."

The overall leader coming into this event was **Chrissy Redden** (CAN, Subaru-Gary Fisher), who finished 16th and relinquished the yellow Tissot leader's jersey to new leader Barbara Blatter - who will be the first woman ever to possess two world cup XC leader's jerseys at the start of Sunday's XC.
