## XC#2: Houffalize, BEL: 25-26.05.2002

# Swiss Sauser & Spanish Fullana Victorious in Houffalize Classic

The **Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup** continued its opening European leg of the 2002 season this weekend at round two, when perhaps the largest fields of competitors in the circuit's history contested a classic event in the hills surrounding *Houffalize*, *Belgium*.



Now in its second decade of organizing world cup events, this location in the Ardennes Forest brought out its usual large crowds, in the tens of thousands. They were treated to two exciting races under cloudy and sometimes wet skies, headlined by wins by **Marga Fullana** (ESP, Orbea) and **Christoph Sauser** (SUI, Volvo Cannondale).

This year's five-lap men's race was destined to be a special one even before the competitors lined up for the start Sunday

afternoon, as an enormous field of 209 riders managed to register for the event this weekend. That meant that it would be even more critical for contenders to have a good start, get up the steep paved climb and into the singletrack without incident if they hoped to maintain contact with the lead.

That sense of urgency could be felt from the gun as the pack - led by **Julien Absalon** (FRA, Motorex-Bianchi) - flew up the first climb and into the first lap with a tight bunch up front - which included many of the same faces from round one. After settling in, seven riders showed that they were in contention, breaking off the front by several seconds and, unlike the women's race earlier, staying together for much of the race.

In the second lap that pack of seven was led by Belgian favorite **Roel Paulissen** (BEL, Rainer-Wurz), who was closely followed by last week's winner **Bart Brentjens** (NED, Giant Bicycle). Close behind them was two-time world cup winner **Christoph Sauser** (SUI, Volvo Cannondale) in third. World and World Cup Champion **Roland Green** (CAN, Trek-Volkswagen) rode in 4th position, followed by **Marco Bui** (ITA,

Lanabau/Rainer-Wurz), **Jose Hermida** (ESP, Motorex-Bianchi) and early leader Julien Absalon (FRA, Motorex-Bianchi).

Thirteen seconds further back another local favorite and former Houffalize winner **Filip Meirhaeghe** (*BEL*, *Specialized*) chased with newcomer **Peter Pouly** (*FRA*). **Miguel Martinez** (*FRA*, *Full Dynamix*) rode nearly 10 seconds further back, illustrating that few would be able to make the jump into the fast-moving leaders' group on this day.

Lap three showed some shuffling within the top ten riders, as the fastest seven kept 16 seconds ahead of the chasers. But Meirhaeghe had shot up to 4th position, while Absalon had dropped to 8th. Meanwhile, Roland Green (CAN, Trek-Volkswagen) looked to repeat his win here last year, and led out the group, with Sauser, Bui and then Meirhaeghe in tow. Paulissen, Brentjens and Hermida rounded out the "magnificent seven."

With just two laps remaining, the men began speeding up the front, dropping one of their members (Bui) and becoming a six-pack of contenders. Sauser took the lead as the riders went

up the famous big climb before the finish, surrounded by thousands of screaming fans. Green was second, followed by Brentjens, Paulissen, Meirhaeghe and Fumic. It was still anyone's race, as only meters separated the top-six men.

The fifth and final lap finally gave up the winner, as the men attacked on the paved climb out of the start/finish to begin their bell lap and see what they had left in their legs. After Green made the first attack, Sauser responded, but the only other riders able to go with them were Meirhaeghe, Brentjens and Paulissen. They raced hard into the technical section and drop by the Fosse d'Outh hotel, then climbed up the longest climb before heading into the further part of the course.

Sauser attacked again and was followed by a surging Paulissen, the two sharing the work up front while 20 seconds back Meirhaeghe and Brentjens rode closely, leaving behind Green as he failed to muster the speed needed for this final-lap contest. Minutes later Sauser led Paulissen into the finish area, the two still close together. But Paulissen crashed just seconds from the finish, losing 11 seconds to Sauser who took his third career world cup victory.

Meirhaeghe rode across 7 seconds later in 3rd place, while Brentjens finished 4th at 20 seconds and Green rounded out the podium in 5th, at 58 seconds. With the points gained from a win and a 4th-place finish, Brentjens kept the blue Tissot leader's jersey, as the cross-country circuit takes time off for the start of the downhill season next week in Scotland.

### **Christoph Sauser,** 1st Place:

"I always dreamed about winning here in Houffalize. I saw the big crowds on TV other years and how much attention the winner gets, and I was jealous. Today I didn't want to work too much, but I felt confident throughout the race. In the last lap I got a gap with Roel, then he closed the gap and led. In the next downhill I passed him, but he came back so I knew I had to be first into the downhill section - I didn't want him to lead there. For me to win here is a big dream come true."



### Roel Paulissen, 2nd Place:

"In the last lap we were all kind of looking at each other, but after a drop Christoph attacked, and I was at the end of the break group in 4th position. I attacked and caught Christoph, we had 15 to 20 seconds lead. He then took 10 seconds out of me on the last downhill, but I closed again at the river near the finish line. But I crashed in the last corner on the slippery rocks, so we didn't get to have a sprint finish."

### Filip Meirhaeghe, 3rd Place:

"I had a bad start, but a good race. I felt better than last week, where I had just come from the road and didn't have the right rhythm for top level mountain bike racing. At the last lap we all attacked at the same place, but you had to race metre by metre - it was like a time trial. The fans were great - they gave me goose bumps - it gave me the motivation to hang on."
