Brentjens and Fullana Win XC Round One

50km100 - Lap time: 20:42.00: 24.52 km/h

Round one of the **Tissot-UCI Mountain Bike World Cup's** 2002 season got underway this weekend in **Madrid, Spain**, as the world's best cross-country racers gathered in the large Casa de Campo park at the city's edge for the first event in a summer-long circuit of racing around the world.



Men's start

Warm sunny skies and hot temperatures brought 25,000 spectators out to this rolling, green course in Spain - and they were treated to two spectacular races on Sunday when a pair of champions made powerful statements about their early-season fitness. First it was two-time *World Champion* **Marga Fullana** (ESP, Orbea) who dominated the women's race, followed by 1996 Olympic Gold Medallist Bart Brentjens (NED, Giant Bicycle) in a similarly impressive effort.

It has been some time - since 1996 actually - since "Sir" **Bart Brentjens** (NED, Giant Bicycle) won a world cup race. That was the same year he won the Olympics in Atlanta, a race that made him one of the most famous mountain bike racers and prompted his country to knight him. Since then he has been racing well with mixed results each season. He won the 2001 European

Championships and holds the number-one UCI overall ranking. But no races of late have equaled what he produced in Madrid Sunday, when he beat current *World Champion* **Roland Green** (CAN, Trek-Volkswagen) by over two minutes in front of an estimated 25,000 spectators.



Brentjens went on a solo attack off the front early in the race, quickly amassing a large lead with a near-perfect ride. For the 34-year-old Brentjens, it was a sweet victory to do so well against riders ten years his junior. And it was a dominant victory for sure. Brentjens took the lead immediately in the race, leading out the long string of 158 riders in the start loop, before they embarked on a high-speed six-lap race. He only had a

slight gap on his chasers after the first lap, but that was about to change.



Bart noticed that he was fastest down the rough stairstep section of the course near the finish, and quickly built a ten-second lead during the first lap. By the end of lap two he was 40 seconds ahead of his nearest chaser, current *Olympic Gold Medallist* **Miguel Martinez** (*FRA*, *Full Dynamix*). Approximately 20 seconds behind Martinez, seven men rode together in pursuit - including Roland Green, **Roel Paulissen** (*BEL*, *Rainer-Wurz*), **Jose Antonio Hermida** (*ESP*, *Motorex-Bianchi*) and **Lado Fumic** (*GER*, *Team T-Mobile*).

Martinez soon flatted a tire and was forced to abandon the race, leaving Green to lead out the chase group, which had been split and now only included Paulissen and Hermida. **Filip Meirhaeghe** (BEL, Specialized), **Marco Bui** (ITA, Lanabau/Rainer-Wurz) and Fumic were in a second chase group at this point.

Brentjens kept increasing his pace and, by the end of the third lap, put another ten seconds on the pack and led the Green/Paulissen/Hermida trio by 1:15. It was 30 more seconds back to the second chase group. Lap four saw the gap increase to 1:35, as Brentjens put an amazing 20 more seconds on the lead. By the end of the 4th lap the gap stood at 1:55. **Christophe Dupouey** (FRA, Giant) was riding alone in 5th position, but would eventually abandon.

In the 5th lap Green and Paulissen were still riding together at 2:05 back, while Hermida rode alone 10 seconds further back. Fumic and Meirhaeghe began to split apart as well, while another trio of riders chased in the top ten, including **Dario Acquaroli** (*ITA*), Bui and **Christoph Sauser** (*SUI*, *Volvo Cannondale*). By the end of lap 5 Fumic and Meirhaeghe were riding solo - only Roland and Roel still working together.

The sixth and final lap saw things finally settle in for the finish. Brentjens kept up his blistering pace, keeping 2:15 between himself and Green. Paulissen fell off the pace though, and was now 5 seconds behind Green, while Hermida was another 30 seconds back and Fumic headed for the final podium spot.

At the finish Bart rolled across the line 2:10 ahead of Green, Paulissen 2:23 off the pace in third place. Hermida finished 4th at 3:01, and Fumic was 5th. For the veteran rider Brentjens, whose wife had a baby in June, it was a wonderful cap to mark the ending portion of a great career.

Bart Brentjens, 1st place:

"It's my job and I like it. In 1994 I also started well here in Madrid, but it's been a long time since I won - since Les Gets. It's unbelievable what I did today. The course was good for me - like Holland with not so much climbing - but the public was good on the steep climb, like in Houffalize. I wasn't able to ride the hill in training, but they helped me in the race. In the final two laps I knew I had a chance to win, and was having a slight problem with my chain - so I rode safe."

Roland Green, 2nd place:

"Roel and I were with Hermida - we weren't really chasing. We knew what the gap was, and I can't speak for Roel, but I was riding at my maximum. We were riding for second place. I liked the circuit, it's technical but for world cups it could be wider."
