## Rockwell, Chausson Win Senior Downhill

**Myles Rockwell** (USA) stunned a large Spanish crowd and indeed an entire industry Saturday afternoon when he won the 2000 men's downhill rainbow jersey by the slimmest of margins. **Anne-Caroline Chausson** (FRA), in contrast, won her fifth-straight senior gold medal by beating **Katja Repo** (FIN) for the second-straight time in Worlds competition.

For Chausson, today's race was one of the toughest tests of her status, as the eight-time champion knew she'd have her work cut out for her, especially after having lost a world cup race last week. Chausson was also only the fifth-fastest qualifier, with Katja Repo (FIN) the second-fastest qualifier and **Marla Streb** (USA) the fastest. It looked like someone might end her amazing World's streak like it was ended today for Vouilloz, but Chausson's determination and strength saw her through to victory.

34 women began the finals, and all finished - within a minute and a half of the winning time and all hoping to make the top-three positions and stand on the podium representing their national team. By the time Chausson came across the finish, **Elke Brutsaert** (USA) had been in the leader's seat for six finishers, until Anne-Caro crossed the line 4.2 seconds faster than the American. Two other *Americans*, **Missy Giove** and **Leigh Donovan** also missed her mark, letting her breathe just a bit easier.

But the race wasn't over, with the top-two qualifying women coming down the mountain, each coming within two seconds of her excellent time. First Repo crossed the line 1.13 seconds off and, by the time Marla Streb came down the mountain, Chausson was nervously sitting in the leader's chair - relieved when her time held once more and she won yet another rainbow jersey.

Chausson has won every world championship race in which she's entered, since winning the Jr. downhill in 1993, 1994 and finally 1995 before graduating to the senior ranks for her wins in 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999 and now in 2000. Repo was the silver medallist last year in Sweden, while Streb's best previous finish was 6th in last year's Worlds.

## Anne-Caroline Chausson, 1st Place;

"I gave my best, and had a pretty good run so if someone had beaten me it would have been tough. I'm really tired and it's hard for me to stand up right now. I had a lot of problems in practice Tuesday and Wednesday and didn't recognize parts of the course because I was working on my bike. If the race had been on Friday, I wouldn't be World Champion right now."

## Katja Repo, 2nd Place:

"I did better than I expected, because this is a very fast course and I had some problems. So I'm very happy that I could ride this fast here. It was very windy at the top before I left, and three times it blew me off my line."

## Marla Streb, 3rd Place:

"I feel very competitive, and I'm psyched. I'm going to win one of these. I tried, and pedaled so hard. The crowd was really quiet so I thought maybe I was going slow - I had been a bit slow in the qualifier in some turns."
